Hi,

We had some really good questions submitted on my Ask Marlon Daily Booth.

I'll be answering some of those today in a video that I email out later today so WATCH for it!

I'm going to try to keep it under 5 minutes in length, although I don't know if that's even POSSIBLE for me!

I think I need to go back to Toastmasters training!

I intended to do the first Ask Marlon video response issue YESTERDAY but instead I spent it tromping around town looking at cameras and video cameras.

If we're talking about SOCIAL MEDIA for getting traffic (and that's the row of the *Traffic Dashboard* I was working on this week, then you HAVE to use photos and video in your communication, Facebook, Twitter links, Youtube and so forth.

It's about COMMUNICATING to people.

Photos and videos help you do that. Which is one of the points of Daily Booth, which I'll get to in a minute. I realize you may have wondered why I am using it and why I sent you there.

Here's the FIRST LAW of buying a camera: KEEP the power cord where you can find it – because it's always proprietary and if you lose it, you're basically screwed. Buying a new power chord costs almost as much as the camera.


Case in point:



And ANOTHER case in point:



Worse than THAT, my Mino is JACKED up because while it was in the USB slot charging up I accidentally brushed my hand against it...NOT a good idea!



THIS is not a good thing.

So, I tromped around town looking at cameras and video cameras. Now, fortunately, I have my ROCKETFISH webcam I used to take the above quick pix in almost NO light....and I thought it was an HD model but it isn't.

So the person who won the Rocketfish TODAY gets something even better. Now I gotta go get the HD model.

Here's a LOUSY shot from my cell:



Here's what the camera looks like:

That shoots HD movies at 720p!

And it's \$120. It has the Carl Zeiss lens that is supposed to be good. And it takes panoramas. Also has image stabilization.

What I love about this puppy is it fits in your pocket or about anything AND if you lose it or beat the crap out of it, it's a hundred twenty bucks. Not like you lost a Nikon D90 SLR.

Nikon D90 I believe was the first SLR (shoots REALLY high quality) that was available at a consumer price. It created quite a ruckus in the market.

The new technology is cmos sensors, which are supposed to be better in low light. I don't know about that but I DO know they are cheaper to manufacture. Not sure the quality is really going to be better.

When I spoke at Joel Comm's reality TV show event "Who wants to be the next Internet millionaire" Charles Trippy was one of the participants. Charles is a huge Youtube star.

Anyway, Charles has a few high end cameras now but he got famous using a little Cybershot SD760 IS as I recall. I'm saying that from memory. But I believe he had the model with the view finder where you could actually turn it around so you could SEE what you're shooting.

All cameras dumped viewfinders because of the cost. You have to go to VIDEO cameras now to get a viewfinder.

My Sanyo has a viewfinder and is 1080 HD. Anyway, shout out to Charles Trippy and let's talk about PowerShots.

It's easy to get names confused. You have the Sony Cybershot and Canon POWERshot.

Canon's Powershot new line is called HS for "High Sensitivity," meaning they're using cmos sensors that they have put a great deal of research into.

The Canon PowerShot SD4500 IS Digital ELPH looks good and is \$274 but they have cheaper ones. Your choices are 720P or 1080i or p. BOTH are HD quality video.

I haven't seen the difference online yet between 720p and 1080 i.

A few terms: SD stands for SD card. That used to be a big deal. Now they ALL use it.

P = Progressive

I = Interlaced

IS = image stabilization

Again, most good cameras and even the cheap ones have that now.

Of course, you can go with higher end video cameras but to get VERY good quality video, you don't have to. It's just SHOCKING what these cheaper cameras will do in terms of video.

I know you may or may not want to do any video. And if you really suck at it, maybe you shouldn't. But you ALWAYS suck at new things at first. Video is a learning curve to look good, edit it and do it well.

What I can say is this:

We are in the COMMUNICATION BUSINESS.

Photos and videos are an INTRICAL part of communication. Would you agree with me on that? So if we don't lose them, we are forfeiting a very powerful tool we have at our disposal.

I'm not a big video person. But I intend to use it more because it's just SUCH a powerful tool. If you THINK your videos have to be totally pro and such to be effective, watch some of the Charles Trippy videos above.

Granted, he's not selling. He's making people amused. But the SAME principle applies...content trumps form. Not that you score points for really bad form.

I think the older you are and the less genetically good looking you are, the more you pay attention to lighting and get a decent camera. By the same token, your CUSTOMERS probably aren't spring chickens if you arne't. So they identify.


Problem solved.

What's more, it's how ENGAGING you are that is the MOST important. It's VERY difficult for younger kids to do good video from what I've seen. But I found one kid that developed a very nice audience because he was crisp, to the point, and just "got" the medium.

Now, for those of you who are like me and aren't YOUNGSTERS anymore a few tips:

1. Photoshop Elements has a thing called a "healing brush." You can look it up on youtube for instructions.

In 15 seconds, it'll remove dark circles under your eyes and erase WRINKLES! How awesome is that?

2. When you shoot video, soft lighting helps remove the hard lines of wrinkles. And don't shoot so close to the camera!

Good lighting helps tons. Yesterday I bought some awesome lights in Target for \$50 and I'm putting a photo of 'em in Traffic Dashboard after I get 'em assembled. The only drawback is you have to assemble them.

I also bought a desklight that clamps onto my desk.

I think it might improve my webcam pix. The ones above are a little lame because the window light is WAY too bright and when I close the blinds it's too dark.

So I think that light might be just right.
